



Pop-Up Blockers and QuickTrac

Certain Features of QuickTrac open in a new window or “Pop-Up” window. In some cases you may find that these features do not work. This is almost always due to a pop-up blocker of some sort installed in your browser.

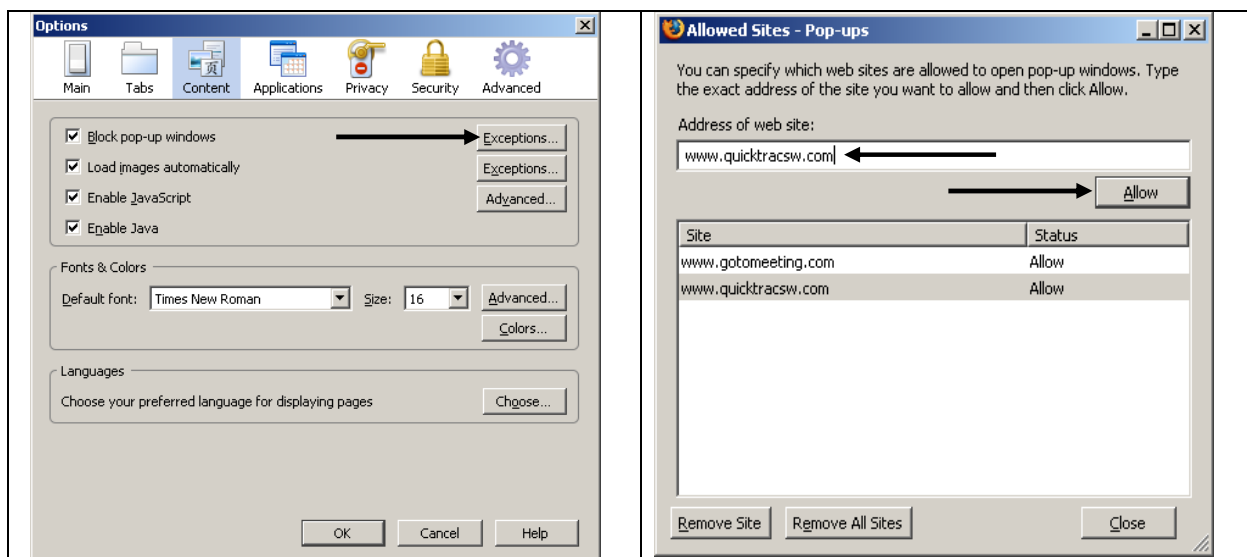
Firefox and newer versions of Internet Explorer on Windows XP also have a built in popup-blocker. This document will outline the steps to take to allow pop-ups from www.quicktracsw.com in Firefox and Internet Explorer. Instructions for disabling other pop-up blockers such as the Yahoo Toolbar and Google Toolbar are detailed in the documentation of those applications, and will not be provided in this document.

Allowing Pop-Ups from www.quicktracsw.com in Firefox

By default, Firefox blocks pop-up windows on web sites. Un-checking this option will disable pop-up blocking. Some sites make legitimate use of pop-up windows such as QuickTrac. Therefore, the pop-up blocking feature has a simple whitelist mechanism to allow certain sites to open pop-ups anyway. To add a site to the whitelist from within Firefox, select TOOLS > OPTIONS > CONTENT from the menu. Click on the ALLOWED SITES OR EXCEPTIONS button (depending on what version you have), enter www.quicktracsw.com, and then click on the ALLOW button.

Allowing Pop-Ups from www.quicktracsw.com in Internet Explorer

From within IE, go to TOOLS > POP-UP BLOCKER > POP-UP BLOCKER SETTINGS



In the POP-UP BLOCKER SETTINGS dialog box, type www.quicktracsw.com into the ADDRESS OF WEBSITE TO ALLOW box, and then click on the ADD button.
